 - a. Write about a significant event or experience, a risk you have taken, or an ethical dilemma you have faced. Explain what it was, your decision around the event (risk or dilemma), how the event (risk or dilemma) impacted you and changed your life.
 - b. Write about a person who has had a grave influence on you. Describe the characteristics of that person and the influence that (s)he has had on you.
 - c. Complete this thought: "If I could change the world, I would..." Give concrete examples of how you would accomplish this, and let us know why you chose this one thing.

The essay should be typed, double spaced, with correct spelling, punctuation and grammar.

Do not put your name on your essay.

 - a. College you plan on attending
 - b. Field of study
 - c. Approximate annual cost of college
 - d. Your career goals and plans
